STATE TAX CREDITS

State Tax Credits (to fund scholarships)

- Donors can receive 100% credit on up to 50% of their annual state income tax obligation.
 - For example, if you owe \$5,000 to the State of Missouri in taxes you can donate up to \$2,500 through tax credits.
- **Who Qualifies for tax credits?**
 - Individuals
 - General Corporations
 - S Corporations

SCHOLARSHIPS - TWO PATHWAYS TO QUALIFY:

Pathway #1

- Students with an IEP
 - Students with an ISP developed under IDEA standards
- * Students must live in Kansas City, Jackson County, or a city with a population of at least 30,000.

Pathway #2

- Students who have been enrolled in public school 12 months prior or entering kindergarten or first grade.
 - and-
 - Make no more than 200% free and reduced income guidelines
- * Students must live in Kansas City, Jackson County, or a city with a population of at least 30,000.
