STATE TAX CREDITS

State Tax Credits (to fund scholarships)

- Donors can receive 100% credit on up to 50% of their annual state income tax obligation.
 - For example, if you owe \$5,000 to the State of Missouri in taxes you can donate up to \$2,500 through tax credits.
- Who Qualifies for tax credits?
 - Individuals
 - General Corporations
 - S Corporations
