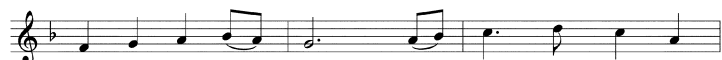

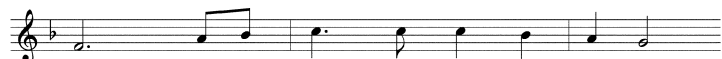

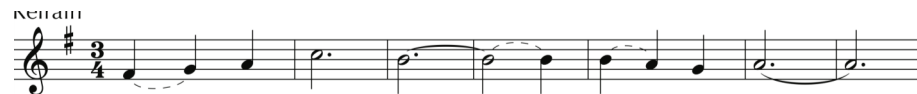

Homily
